## **Drake Employee Perks and Discounts**

- <u>Verizon Employee Discount</u>. Verizon offers Drake employees a discount of 18% on qualifying rate
  plans. Visit a Verizon corporate owned retail location with either a pay stub from within the last 60
  days or a Drake ID with both a first and last name for employment verification.
- AT&T Employee Discount. AT&T Wireless provides Drake employees with a 15% discount off rate plans and data plans. The unlimited rate plans are not discountable and the additional lines on family plans are not discountable. The \$15 and \$20 personal data plans are not discountable. Features such as text messaging are not discountable. You also receive a \$50 credit towards monthly service when you activate a new line. Sign up using your drake.edu address.
- Sprint Employee Discount. Sprint offers Drake employees no activation fees and \$5 off per line with autopay on the Unlimited Plan. Present your Drake ID card at the store.
- Interstate All Battery Center Discount. Drake employees are eligible for discounted pricing for personal purchases at Interstate All Battery Center, located at 1090 73rd St, Windsor Heights and 810 N. Ankeny Boulevard, Ankeny. To obtain the discounted pricing, please present your Drake ID card at the store. It will vary with the product purchased and will be taxable.
- Free DART Bus Rides. Drake employees can simply show their Drake employee ID to the DART bus driver and ride the DART bus for free. Routes can be accessed online at www.ridedart.com.
- Drake Bike Library. Drake employees can check out a bicycle for the day for free by bringing their Drake ID to the Student Life Center in Olmsted. Employees must sign a liability waiver and will be given a helmet to wear and a key to the bike lock.
- BCycle. Drake employees can buy an annual pass at the discounted price of \$24.80 (normally \$84.80), to rent a BCycle for an unlimited amount of 1-hour rides. BCycle memberships can be purchased at DesMoines.BCycle.com; using your drake.edu email address and the promotional code: Bulldogs. There are four BCycle stations around campus, offering faculty, staff, and students a convenient way to bike around campus and Des Moines. - <u>Free Microsoft Office Software and Discounted Adobe Creative Cloud for Home Computers</u>. For more information, go to drake.onthehub.com.
- <u>Free Lynda.com Access</u>. Lynda.com provides a vast online library of instructional videos covering the latest software, creative, and business skills. It's free for all Drake students, faculty and staff. This may be phased out in 2018 or 2019.
- <u>Free Mango Languages Training</u>. From Spanish to Swahili and Shakespeare to Ancient Greek,
  Mango has virtually everyone's language and culture curiosities covered. Whether studying abroad
  or strengthening a particular language skill, Drake employees can achieve their language-learning
  goals with Mango in over 70 languages.
- Adventureland Park Discount Tickets. Drake employees can receive discounted tickets to Adventureland Park. Go to www.adventurelandresort.com/corp. Create an Adventureland

- account using your @drake.edu email address. You will be routed to their online discount ticketing website to complete your purchase. Email Ross@adventurelandpark.com with questions.
- Des Moines Performing Arts Discount Tickets. Receive discounted tickets to select shows and performances at the Civic Center, Stoner Theater, Temple Theater, and Cowles Commons. Go to <a href="http://my.desmoinesperformingarts.org/single/eventlisting.aspx">http://my.desmoinesperformingarts.org/single/eventlisting.aspx</a>, enter 1718EGROUPS in the Promo Code field and click the submit button to access special Group E-Tickets presales and discounts.
- Office Depot/OfficeMax Employee Discount. Drake employees can register their personal credit card with an Office Depot/OfficeMax retail store to receive a 5 or 10 percent discount off the regular retail price (promotions excluded). To register your card go to <a href="https://business.officedepot.com/userprofile/registerPCard.do?billTold=75295904">https://business.officedepot.com/userprofile/registerPCard.do?billTold=75295904</a>. Enter your personal credit card number and click submit. No additional confirmation will be sent but the card will be linked to the Employee Purchase Program (EPP) account within 48 hours. When you visit an Office Depot/OfficeMax store, present the credit card you registered to receive the discount. When the card is swiped you will receive the discounted price or retail sale price whichever is lowest. The credit card linked to the EPP account must be presented in order to receive the discount even if you are paying with cash.
- **Keck Parking Discount**. Drake employees receive a 50% discount (\$3.50 per day) at the Keck Airport Shuttle Parking lot at 5555 Fleur Drive. Just take a ticket at the gate and park your vehicle in any open space. A shuttle will pick you up and drop you off outside the terminal. Upon returning to the airport, the shuttle will drop you off at your car. When you pull up to the cashier window, identify yourself as a Drake employee and show them your Drake ID card or business card if asked. You can get this discount for both business and personal travel.
- Enterprise Car Rental Discount. Drake employees may rent a car for personal use through
  Enterprise and receive the same rates as the University. For the personal use account go to
  <a href="https://www.neterprise.com">www.enterprise.com</a> and book using the personal use account number, XZ6299F. Once you sign
  up, you will receive a packet of information via email and you can print off a card. You may also
  enroll in the Emerald Club with National which is the sister company of Enterprise at
  <a href="https://www.nationalcar.com/offer/XZ62113">https://www.nationalcar.com/offer/XZ62113</a>.
- Irene's Flowers Discount. Drake employees can receive a 10% discount at Irene's Flowers (1151 25<sup>th</sup> Street, Des Moines) by showing a Drake ID.
- Home Incentive Plan. Bankers Trust Company, Neighborhood Finance Corporation (NFC), and
  Drake University have teamed up to offer a variety of benefits to Drake employees. Drake
  University can offer employees up to \$3,500 to be used towards a down payment and/or closing
  costs for purchases adjacent to the campus. See MAP.
- <u>Drake Dining CINCH Card Program</u>. Next time you are at Hubbell dining, ask the cashier for a
  CINCH card registration form. Fill it out and your first meal is half off. You will receive a punch card
  to use during future visits. After that, you will receive a free meal after every three meals that you
  purchase.

- <u>Drake University Bookstore Employee Discount</u>. Drake employees can receive a discount from the Drake University Bookstore by showing their Drake ID at check-out.
- <u>Drake Art Exhibit, Music Performances, and Theatre Performances</u>. Drake employees receive free
  admission to Drake Art Exhibits and discounted tickets to Drake Theatre Performances. Employees
  also receive free admission to Drake Music Performances (except Opera which offers discounts to
  employees with a Drake ID, and Jazz and ticketed choir events which do not offer discounts).
- Free and Discounted Tickets to Various Drake University Sporting Events. Drake employees
  receive discounted rates to Drake sporting events. Go to <a href="https://www.draketix.com/single">https://www.draketix.com/single</a> for
  faculty/staff single event ticket prices and <a href="https://www.draketix.com/season">https://www.draketix.com/season</a> for faculty/staff
  season ticket prices. In addition, the Drake Athletics Department typically offers at least one
  Faculty/Staff Day with a complementary ticket offer at each of their ticketed sports (excluding the
  Relays). This and other specials are announced in OnCampus.
- Cowles Library. Drake employees have access to all the library's resources. Some databases and subscriptions require registration. For example, the New York Times subscription requires a registration with a Drake email address and you must be on campus when you register. You also need to re-register every year. Most resources are available remotely and are accessed with Drake ID and password.
- Drake Recreation Facilities. The Drake University Bell and Knapp Center fitness facilities are free to
  full-time employees. You must show your Drake ID at check-in. Adjunct and part-time employees
  may purchase a discounted fitness pass. Employees are welcome to bring their family members to
  the workout facilities at a discounted rate as well. Passes may be purchased at the Bell Center

- Group X Fitness Classes. Classes are free for all Drake employees. They are offered throughout the year with a new schedule each semester. Attend 15 classes per semester and earn a shirt! All classes are held in the Fitness Studio at the Bell Center, unless otherwise told and all equipment is provided. Register online or using the IMLeagues mobile app.
- Body Composition Analysis, Fitness Assessments, and Personal Training. Drake employees can participate in a body composition analysis or fitness assessment for \$12. The body composition analysis will tell you your Body Mass Index and Body Fat Percentage and what that means when determining certain health risk factors. The fitness assessment is designed to evaluate your health and fitness. Send an email to wellness@drake.edu to schedule an appointment. Drake employees may also register for personal training sessions. Sessions are 30 minutes in duration and take place at the Bell Center. A customized exercise program will be designed for you. Send an email to wellness@drake.edu for pricing information or to schedule an appointment.
- <u>Faculty/Staff Golf League</u>. Drake's faculty and staff golf league takes place May to August. Players golf nine holes on Wednesdays at 4 p.m. at Grandview Golf Course. Each team of two will pay a fee that goes toward green fees for 10 weeks, plus league prizes and tournament winners. - <u>Free One-on-One Consultation with Registered Dietitian</u>. Drake employees may schedule an appointment with Sodexo campus dietitian Lucas Flaherty at lucas.flaherty@drake.edu.

- <u>Bulldog Bucks</u>. Drake employees can turn their Drake ID into a debit card by loading funds onto
  the Drake ID card and scanning instead of using cash. Funds can be added during business hours in
  the Student Services Center. Funds can also be added online in the <u>eAccounts</u> portal and a free
  mobile application is available to add funds for those who have saved a payment method on the

- <u>Community Service Leave</u>. Drake University recognizes the importance of community involvement
  and encourages employees to participate in volunteer and service activities. Review the policy for

- <u>Employee and Family Resources (EFR)</u>. EFR provides a variety of services and resources for employees including counseling, elder care, legal consultation, and financial consultation.
- Drake Socials. Employees are encouraged to attend Drake Socials. They provide a wonderful
  opportunity to mingle with other faculty and staff in a casual environment. They are usually held at
  the Shivers Hospitality Suite, adjacent to the Knapp Center. Check OnCampus for upcoming dates
  and times.
- Employee Wellness Programs. Drake employees may participate in a variety of wellness programs throughout the year. Most programs are free for faculty and staff. A few include small fees. Examples of past events include Couch to 5K training, Club Ped 10,000 Step Walking Program, Financial Fitness Online Tutorials, Holiday Trimmings Weight Challenge, Chair Massages, Weight Watchers at Work, Flu Shots, Bone Density Screenings, Vascular Screenings, Des Moines Corporate Games, CPR/AED/1st Aid certification, and Healthy BINGO.
