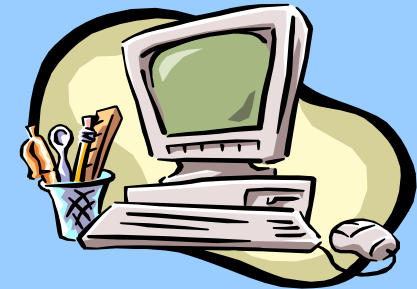

The Writing Workshop is directed by a faculty member and staffed by undergraduate students who are trained to tutor. They are also experienced writers and friendly critics.

You may visit a tutor by appointment or establish a time to meet a tutor on a regular basis.

What can you expect from the Writing Workshop

The Writing Workshop serves undergraduate, graduate, and law students. It can help you with

coming up with ideas for papers;

learning new strategies appropriate for a particular writing or reading task;

making sense of assignments and assigned reading material;


revising organization, argument, viewpoint or perspective;

and resolving serious problems with word choice, grammar, etc. that impede communication.
