Photo Contest Guidelines

Categories

Capture the Culture: share the images that you think best represent the local culture and/or highlight your cultural experience while studying abroad or in the U.S.

Global Learning: share the academic highlights of your international experience.

The Great Outdoors: these pictures can include outdoor scenes, nature images, landscapes AND cityscapes that you have witnessed during your domestic and international travels.

Most Epic Selfie: show us your most epic selfie!

**You can earn extra 5 votes per photo for showing off your Drake gear in any of these photos.*

Eligibility

The contest is open to all Drake students and staff/faculty who have had a **Drake-related international education or work experience** (e.g., international students, study abroad students, faculty leading travel seminars, etc.) Drake International will not accept photo submissions from individuals or organizations outside of the University.

Photo Requirements

- ✓ A maximum of **four** photos per person may be entered. Please, note that only **one photo per category** will be accepted.
- ✓ Photos can be taken abroad or in the United States.
- ✓ Photos must be your **original** work.
- ✓ Each photo should have the following information:
 - Your name
 - Location of photo (city/country)
 - Preferred category (Capture the Culture, Global Learning, the Great Outdoors, the Most Epic Selfie)
 - A brief description or caption (25 words or fewer)
- ✓ Photos must be of high resolution (300 dpi/at least 1800 x 1200 pixels).
- ✓ Email your photos to studyabroad@drake.edu.
- ✓ Contestants retain all the rights on his/her photos. By submitting your photo, however, contestants are agreeing that they grant Drake University and Drake International royalty-free use of submitted photographs in displays and in print and electronic publications. The artist will be fully credited in all such displays and publications.
- ✓ Please, use good judgement when submitting your photos. Drake International reserves the right to approve, reject, edit, or make special consideration for any content submitted to the event page. Submissions that don't have a complete description or violate the University's Statement of Principles will not be accepted. The University also reserves the right to remove unacceptable comments or photos uploaded to the event page. Unacceptable comments include but are not limited to: Profane or obscene language or content; content that promotes, fosters, or perpetrates discrimination on the basis of race, color, national origin, creed, religion, age, disability, sex, pregnancy, gender identity or expression, sexual orientation, genetic information, veteran status or any characteristic protected by law in its educational programs and activities, admission, or employment.

Contest Timeline

October 30th- November 12th: submit your photos to studyabroad@drake.edu and vote for your favorites on the Drake International and Study Abroad Facebook page:

November 14th: 20 finalists (5 per each category) are selected and displayed for in-person voting during the International Education Week 2018 events on campus (events to be announced)

November 15th: in-person voting ends; the winners are announced (details to be announced)

Winners

The photo in each category that receives the most likes will be the **category winner**; the photo with the most votes overall will be the **overall winner**.

Contestants cannot win in more than one category. If a contestant receives the most overall likes, they win overall winner rather than category winner. The photo with the second most likes in that category will win that category. In the event that the same contestant receives the most likes in more than one category, that contestant will win the category prize for the photo that receives more likes.
